I want to thank these candidates for showing support to provide relief for their fellow citizens in these hard economic times with high inflation.

A toll rebate program would impact every commuter who regularly uses I-66, the 495 Beltway and even perhaps the Dulles Toll Road. This plan would be modeled after successful policies in Florida which offer rebates to frequent commuters on toll roads. Obviously, it would be crafted to fit Virginia circumstances.

Many jobs such as nurses, firemen, policemen, tradespeople have varied hours and could never be part of a consistent 3 person carpool.

Also, after COVID many people have changed their work habits, spending several days working from home.

The proposals these candidates are offering are common sense and would be good for commuters here in Northern Virginia.
